- Qualifying rounds
 All qualifying round matches have been taken into consideration for all seasons.
 Teams eliminated in the qualifying round = results of the qualifying round have been taken
- Participating teams in the elite round = results of the qualifying & elite rounds have been taken into consideration
 Seeded teams = results of the elite round have been taken into consideration
 Match points: Victory = 3 points; Draw= 1 point; Defeat = 0 point

Bonus points

- Qualification to elite round (incl. seeded teams) = 3 points
 Qualification to the final round = 3 points
 Qualification to the final round = 3 points
 European Champions = 3 additional bonus points i.e. Sweden (2011/12), France (2012/13); Netherlands (2013/14)
- Runner-up = 2 additional bonus points i.e. Spain (2011/12), England (2012/13; Spain (2013/14)
- Semi-finalists = 1 additional bonus point i.e. Portugal & Denmark (2011/12), Germany & Finland (2012/13); Norway & Republic of Ireland (2013/14)

The coefficient for each season has been calculated by taking the number of points obtained (including bonus points) and dividing it by the number of matches.

The three annual coefficients have then been added together to produce the overall coefficient used for the ranking list.

Associations with the same overall coefficient have been separated according to the following criteria:

- 1) Higher number of matches.
- 2) Higher coefficient from the most recent season, i.e. 2013/14 season.
- 3) Higher coefficient from the next most recent season, i.e. 2012/13 season.
- 4) Higher coefficient from the next most recent season, i.e 2011/12 season.
- 5) Superior goal difference from the most recent season, i.e. 2013/14 season.
